TRANSPORTATION PLANS



PLEASE RETURN BY JUNE 1!

- 1) First-year staff members should plan to arrive at camp on Wednesday, June 9th to begin new staff orientation at 1:30 p.m. on Thursday. Returning staff should arrive on Thursday, June 10th and counselor training will begin Friday, June 11th.
2) All staff coming to camp from outside Douglas County Wisconsin should return the form below, regardless of mode of transportation to camp.
3) First-year Junior Counselors: Please follow directions for travel that you received with your contract.

TRAVEL OPTIONS

CAR: If you are driving and have room for passengers OR if you wish to be a passenger, we will try to connect you with others in your area. NOTE: The more people that can travel in a car, the cheaper it is for everyone, even if this means shipping baggage. (See baggage explanation below.)

BUS: A Greyhound service runs daily from Chicago to Duluth, MN. Call (800)-231-2222 or check www.greyhound.com to confirm departure times. The cost is approximately \$100 one-way. Once you have made a reservation and know your arrival time in Duluth, let the camp office know at (715) 374-2275 and we'll pick you up.

MINNEAPOLIS SHUTTLE: If you fly into Minneapolis you can reserve a seat with Skyline Shuttle that will pick you up at the Terminal and drive you to Downtown Duluth for \$42.00 one way. Contact them at skylineshuttle.com. Please note that Skyline does have luggage restrictions—we recommend visiting their website for more details. See below for baggage shipping instructions if needed.

FLY: If you fly, you'll connect with Northwest in Minneapolis and proceed to Duluth. With some connections, it doesn't cost much more to take the Duluth leg; with others, it is prohibitive, and busing from Minneapolis to Duluth (three hours) is the economical alternative. We will meet flights or buses in Duluth, not Minneapolis. Send us your flight number and arrival time on the form below for a pick-up. WHEN MAKING RETURN TRIP AIRLINE RESERVATIONS, KEEP IN MIND THAT ON AUGUST 12 YOU CANNOT LEAVE DULUTH UNTIL 12 p.m. AND MINNEAPOLIS BEFORE 4 p.m. On August 12, we'll provide a van to take you from camp that will get you to the Minneapolis airport by 2:30 p.m.

BAGGAGE: UPS or FedEx are usually the cheapest and easiest options. Ship UPS or FedEx to you, c/o Camp Nebagamon, 11454 Camp Nebagamon Drive, Lake Nebagamon, WI 54849.
