Camp Nebagamon holds space for those whose enrollment forms are completed with fees paid on schedule. Enrollments are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis in each age group (third through ninth grade completed) with consideration given to returning campers until December 1 and geographic distribution.

When all space in an age group is reserved, a numerical waiting list is started. As space becomes available, a deposit is required to secure the enrollment.

Enrollment is a firm commitment consisting of an enrollment form with **signatures** of camper and parent or legal guardian and a **\$1000 deposit**.

Cancellation and Enrollment Change Policies

- I. By February 1
 - A. Full reimbursement for cancellation due to medical condition, prohibiting camper from attending Nebagamon.
 - B. Reasons other than medical, reimbursement minus a \$200 processing fee.
 - C. No penalty for change from eight to four weeks.
- II. After February 1
 - A. Full refund only for medical reasons.
 - B. For cancellation other than medical reasons, all tuition received is forfeited.

- No reduction in tuition is allowed for late arrival or early departure.
- Camp Nebagamon is not responsible for the loss of personal property due to fire, theft, or carelessness.
- Parental permission is assumed for the use of any photograph for promotional purposes of Camp Nebagamon (includes publication on our website).
- Parental permission is assumed for the participation in the wilderness tripping program, unless otherwise indicated.

TUITION INCLUDES: Round trip bus fare between Minneapolis and camp, laundry, camp's yearbook *The Keylog*, camp's summer DVD, most wilderness tripping fees (exceptions are Madeline Island Ferry, 8th and 9th grade Big Trips, additional Boundary Waters Canoe Area fees, Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore, Apostle Islands sea kayaking trips, and Lake Superior sailing trips), candy line (three times a week), and Wisconsin sales tax. Medical Treatment: Tuition covers the cost of most procedures, medicine, and treatment rendered by our doctors and nurses in camp's health center. Parents cover the cost of treating pre-existing conditions or those, which in our physician's opinion, require off-premises consultation, prescriptions, or hospitalization.
