Your thoughtful completion of the Objectives and Personality Form helps us immeasurably in providing a positive and productive summer for your son. **All parents should complete Parts I and II. NEW parents should complete Part III**, which is optional for old parents.

SKILL OBJECTIVES (Part I): Counselors can do an effective job of guiding your boy's productivity IF they are aware of his and your interests and goals. Your responses to the questions in Part II and III are equally important in guiding your child.

PERSONALITY (Parts II and III): Some parents are reluctant to share information about a child's behaviors or past experiences, fearing that the information will be misused or that their child will be treated differently. As parents, and as camp directors, we appreciate these concerns. We also know how valuable such information can be in making your child's adjustment to camp happy—a goal that we know parents share. Having prior knowledge of school difficulty, bedwetting, family loss, divorce, or a major change in your child's life can sensitize us to his behavior and his need for appropriate responses from adults—for patience, understanding, and reassurance. We assure you that such information will be used discreetly and will only be shared with those who directly supervise your child: his cabin counseling team and his village (unit) director (when appropriate).
